Entry Fee

\$30 for entry of up to 3 images.

\$35 for entry of 4 to 6 images.

Once entry is submitted, fees are non-refundable regardless of acceptance into the exhibition.

Images

All entries must be submitted electronically via online *Submittable* platform. Follow all instructions listed on mainstreetarts.submittable.com. Judging will be done entirely from JPEGs. No other formats will be accepted. JPEGs must be 72 dpi, at least 1200 pixels in one direction.

Insurance

Artwork will be insured against loss, damage, or theft while on gallery premises. Artists should insure work during shipping to and from the gallery.

Shipping

Artists will pay shipping to and from gallery (for unsold work), pay close attention to shipping dates after notification of acceptance. Buyer will pay for shipping if work is purchased

Sales

All sales will be handled by gallery staff at Main Street Arts. The gallery retains 40% commission on all sales, please price your work accordingly. All work accepted must be for sale. Online sales will be an option for artists who are selected for the exhibition. Sales made in Main Street Arts online store will be under the same terms as in-gallery sales.

Selected work

All entries must be of original design and personal execution. Artwork which differs greatly from submission images will not be accepted. The exhibition will be held in the second floor gallery at Main Street Arts and online
